Malawi Liverpool Wellcome Trust is a partner in the MPhil in Genomic Science programme based at the Wellcome Trust Sanger Institute, Hinxton, UK.

The Wellcome Trust Sanger Institute is a world leading genomics institute at the forefront of experimental, computational and translational genomic research. Faculty members apply large scale genomic tools to a range of research areas, including the investigation of human genetic variation in health and disease, experimental genetic analysis of gene function and genome variation in cells and model organisms, biological studies of bacterial and parasitic human pathogens, and computational interpretation of genomic data. Genomics is assuming an increasingly prominent place in biological research. The MPhil in Genomic Science programme is being run in partnership with nine institutions in low and middle income countries, and will equip students with a unique blend of experimental and informatics skills, maximising their competitiveness for future opportunities.

The six partner institutions without a current student on the programme can each choose one local candidate, who will then compete for one of three fully-funded (stipend and University fees) 1-year research MPhil studentships, based at the Wellcome Trust Sanger Institute, starting 1st October 2018.
