- Malawian-based candidates with a strong academic track record.
- Proof of PhD/Master's offer/admission
- Prof of stipend for the entire period of study
- Proof of full project funding.

Application Requirements

Your application should include:

- Application letter (suitability, motivation, career ambition)
- Proposed research group & letter of support from group leader from MLW
- Letter of support from proposed supervisor(s), indicating a plan for stipend and research costs
- Detailed CV (academic performance, achievements, grants, outputs)
- Certified copies of certificates & transcripts
- Proof of Master's/PhD registration/offer of admission
- Proof of stipend and research cost support
